1. About this Cookie Policy

The Cookie Policy (the “Policy”) is designed to inform the website users of Amical Limited (the “Amical”, “We”, “Us”) on the user of cookies and similar tracking technologies. Amical, is a Cyprus incorporated entity, with registration number HE 45311, having its registered office at 11 Florinis Street, City Forum, Office 102, Nicosia 1065, Cyprus.

This Policy explains what cookies are and how we use them, the types of cookies we use, such as the information we collect using cookies and how that information is used, and how to control cookie preferences. 2. What are cookies ?

Cookies are small text files used to store small information. They are stored on your device when the website is loaded on your browser. These cookies help us to make the website work properly, to make it more secure, to provide a better user experience, to understand how the website is performing and to analyze what is working and where it needs improvement.

3. How do we use cookies ?

First Party Cookies

Like most online services, our website uses first party and third-party cookies for several purposes. First party cookies are primarily necessary for the proper functioning of the website, and they do not collect any of your personally identifiable data.

Third Party Cookies

The third-party cookies used on our website are primarily for understanding how the website performs, how you interact with our website, keeping our services secure, and overall providing you with an improved user experience and helping you speed up your future interactions with our website.

4. What types of cookies do we use ?

Essential Cookies

Some cookies are essential for you to experience the full functionality of our site. They allow us to maintain user sessions and prevent any security threats. They do not collect or store any personal information. For example, these cookies allow you navigate through our website in a secure and safe manner.

Statistical Cookies

These cookies store information such as the number of visitors to the website, the number of unique visitors, the pages of the website visited, the source of the visit, etc. This data helps us understand and analyze website performance and areas for improvement.

Functional Cookies

These are cookies that help certain non-essential functionalities of our website. These features include embedding content such as videos or sharing website content on social media platforms.

Preferential Cookies

These cookies help us store your settings and different browsing preferences so that you have a better and efficient experience on future visits to the website.

5. How can I control cookie preferences?

If you decide to change your preferences later during your browsing session, you can click on the “Privacy and Cookies Policy” tab on your screen. This will display the consent notice again, allowing you to change your preferences or withdraw your consent entirely.
